

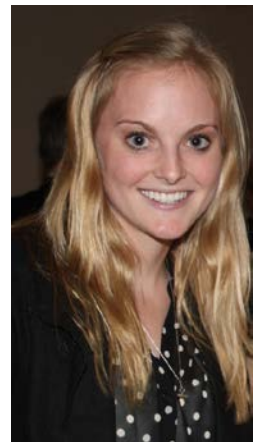
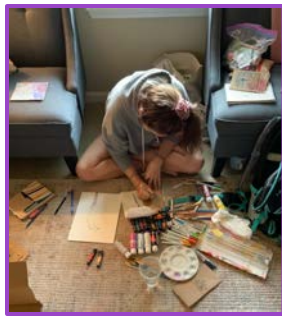

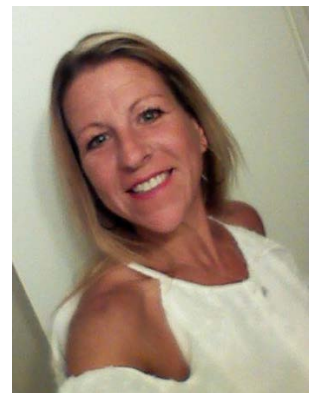


100 FINANCIAL AWARDS GIVEN!!!

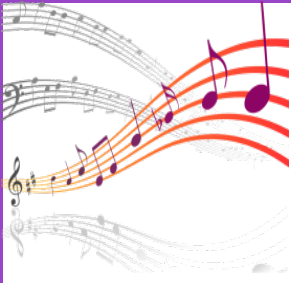
